

Kiddy Academy Toilet Training and intimate care

It is the aim of Kiddy Academy to provide support for parents whose children are starting toilet training. We offer advice and reassurance on whether a child is ready and whilst they are learning to use the toilet. We also have home resources available for parents to access should they require it.

Good hygiene practices are always followed at the nursery and the children are shown the toilet and how to flush the toilet and wash their hands each time they use the toilet. Pictures and signage will reinforce safe, hygienic toileting. "Little accidents" will be treated calmly, sympathetically and in a way which does not make the child feel that they have done anything wrong.

Children will have intimate areas cleaned by a DBS checked member of staff and the staff member will never go into a toilet and lock the door. The children will be encouraged wherever possible to exercise their right to privacy and will be encouraged to go into the toilet and close and lock the door. They will also be encouraged to wipe and clean intimate areas for themselves. Staff will provide assistance where necessary, but encouragement will be given to limit this.

Parents will be encouraged to supply plenty of changes of clothes, placed on the individual child's peg. Where there are no clothes available for the child, the nursery will provide clothes.
