- We all respect each other and be respected by adults, therefore swearing and the use of disrespectful terms should not be used by children, or other adults.
- Respect all people regardless of age, gender, race, ethnicity, sexuality and or disability
- We will not tolerate any verbal or physical aggression towards parents or staff

Parent/Carers/Visitors may have a different outlook on shouting and smacking children. At Kiddy Academy we would like everybody to respect each other and take another outlook when disciplining your child by not shouting or smacking and use a therapeutic approach.

Our code of conduct acknowledges that we are free from drugs, smoking and alcohol. Anybody found do be doing so will be asked to leave the premises.

Please do not use your phone in part of the nursery except for the foyer.

Social network is a great way to stay in touch, please do not use social network to discuss confidential information to harass or upset others. If you see or hear anything that has made you uncomfortable about the setting, do not hesitate to come and discuss it with the management team.
