

Kiddy Academy Infectious Diseases

Parents are asked to keep their children at home if they have any infection, and inform the Nursery School as to the nature of the infection so that we can alert other parents, and make careful observations of any child who seems unwell.

Parents are asked not to bring into the setting any child who has been vomiting or had diarrhoea until at least 48 hours has elapsed since the last attack.

Chicken Pox - Children need to be absent from the Nursery for 5 days from the onset of the rash.

If your child has not been his/her normal self at home but is not showing signs of illness when you bring him/her to nursery please mention it to the staff and let them know how best to contact you through the day.

If there are any other infectious diseases that may arise, management will consult Guidance on Infection Controls in schools and other childcare settings (issued by the Health Protection Agency) and assess accordingly.
